The sweepstakes winner will receive points, in addition to other points won for horse, as follows: 1 point for a "B" ride, 2 points for an "A" ride, 3 points for an "AA" ride.

For example: Rider places 3rd and horse places 1st and sweepstakes.

Calculate points as follows:

If 10 competitors in the class horsemanship points = 12 / horse points = 16 for placing + 2 points for sweepstakes for a total of 18 points.

If 4 competitors in the class horsemanship points = 8, / horse points = 12 for placing + 2 points for sweepstakes for a total of 14 points.

If there are 6 riders (horsemanship) in a div/class...but one is HDC then the points are figured on 5 competitors. But, if the horse is competing, then the points are for 6 horses.
